

SPEED INDICATOR DEVICE (SID) REPORT - DARSHAM
1 February to 28 February 2023

The following figures are for the period 1 to 28 February 2023, measuring eastbound traffic along The Street in the SID's location off the A12.

Total number of vehicles exceeding 40 mph	73	0.6%	<i>Unchanged on previous report. There is no pattern to the incidents, but they all occur during the daytime between 07:00 and 21:00 – possibly delivery vans?</i>
Total number of vehicles exceeding 45 mph	12	0.1%	<i>Slightly down on previous report There is no pattern to the incidents, but they all occur during the daytime between 07:00 and 21:00 – possibly delivery vans?</i>
Total number of vehicles exceeding 50 mph	0	0%	<i>No incidents, and so an improvement on the previous period, which saw two incidents recorded.</i>

Trends and observations

- Compliance with the speed limit remains largely good.
- There is still no clearly identifiable pattern to incidents of excessive speed, other than that speeding predominantly occurs during the day. Based on anecdotal evidence, I wonder if these incidents can be attributed to delivery vans?
