Total number of vehicles exceeding 45 mph	30	0.11%	Unchanged on previous report. Nearly all incidents took place during the day. The majority of incidents occurred between 15 and 19 April, and 2 and 7 May (Coronation Week).
Total number of vehicles exceeding 50 mph	5	0.01%	Increase on previous report, when there were no incidents – no pattern to the incidents, all of which occurred during the day time.

## **Trends and observations**

- A **marked** increase in the volume of traffic (+19.3%), which would indicate the impact of tourism in our village, perhaps supported by the fact that the more serious speeding incidents occurred during Coronation Week with its several public holidays.
