Trends and observations

- Most vehicles enter Darsham between 6.00 am and 6.00 pm. The busiest periods are generally between 12:00 noon and 2.00 pm, and again between 4.00 pm and 5.00 pm.
- Most speeding violations are recorded on **weekdays** between 6.30 am and 7.30 am. This is consistent throughout the five-week period.
- The worst period for speeding violations was between 9.00 pm and 10.00 pm on Tuesday 5 April. This coincides with the closure of the A12 that night.
- The average volume of vehicles entering Darsham from the A12 via The Street has increased marginally over the five-week period.
- The number of speeding violations has **increased** over the five-week period.
- Average speeds recorded, both below and above the speed limit, have **not changed** over the five-week period.
