Trends and observations

- The number of vehicles entering Darsham from the A12 via The Street has increased slightly compared with the first report (3%).
- An increased share of vehicles are adhering to the speed limit compared with the first report (75%, up from 73%).
- Although the share of vehicles breaking the speed limit has decreased (from 27% to 25%), the number of serious violations has increased significantly.
